✖ Alberta is the largest oil and gas producer in Canada and has been seen as innovative and progressive with a robust environmental research program that is inclusive of both industry and government. The tangible value of which has been demonstrated through regulation change, significant financial savings for industry, improved operating practices, and continuous improved environmental and social performance. Industry and government have collectively agreed there is significant value in the Alberta Upstream Petroleum Research Fund (AUPRF) Program.

The Canadian Association of Petroleum Producers (CAPP) and the Explorers and Producers Association of Canada (EPAC) jointly request that the Alberta Energy Regulator's (AER) administration fee process be used to annually collect the required funds to fund the AUPRF Program.
