AUPRF is a unique collaborative platform between the Alberta Energy Regulator, the Government of Alberta and industry. The ARPC also includes stakeholder representation from Environment Climate Change Canada, BC Oil and Gas Commission, and the Saskatchewan Ministry of Energy and Resources.
